DOCUMENTS TO COMPLETE AND RETURN – DATED INFORMATION

- Check, complete, and return** the information on the **Delegate Response Form** to Dave Cobb, Director in the enclosed envelope **as soon as possible. Deadline - June 1st**
- Complete the enclosed **medical form**. Return it to Dave. **Deadline – June 1st**.
- Transcripts:** Request your school send an official **transcript** be sent to Green Mountain Boys' State, Attn: Scholarship Director, 164 Calista Avenue, Lyndonville, VT 05851. Third quarter grades & test scores are fine. Please do not wait for final grades from your current year.
- Direct descendent of a military veteran** may qualify for the **Samsung Scholarship**. All local winners also qualify for consideration at the national level as well.
- The application must be completed on-line at the National American Legion web-site PRIOR to coming to Boys' State.** Click Programs, then Scholarships. Check the VT Legion Web site at www.vtlegion.org

PACKING LIST ~ WHAT TO BRING
