COMMUNITY SERVICE - Maximum of 35 points This could include both on duty and off duty activities as noted and referenced in the supporting write up and recommendation for the candidate.	22									
PROFESSIONAL CAREER - Maximum of 40 points This category includes education and courses attended as well as those that they instructed. Certifications are considered as well. How the candidate contributed to his agency and its mission is important. Professional awards and achievements are included in this category.	30									
HEROISM - Maximum of 20 points Must be noted in the recommendation with a degree of spedificity.	8									
OTHER - Maximum of 5 Points This could include local, non-professional, awards and recognition - Discretionary based on award narrative/recommendation.	4
