VALUABLES

DO NOT BRING VALUABLES WITH YOU. There are no facilities for storing of valuables. We cannot be responsible for any lost valuables. This includes jewelry, cell phone, computers, ipad, etc. All electronic devices will be taken if brought to the academy.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE - GROOMING

Since the American Legion, Department of Vermont, and the Vermont Criminal Justice Training Council sponsor the program, and all participation is strictly voluntary, we insist upon certain dress attire and personal grooming regulations. The Grooming Code calls for boys to have a neat haircut with hair trimmed and tapered and for the girls that the hair be neat and not so long (tied back) as to create a safety hazard. Cleanliness is paramount so attention must be made to personal grooming daily.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

- Each Cadet will bring his/her own personal toiletries (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, razor, brush, comb, etc.)
- o Towels and facecloths for a week
- Shower shoes (flip/flops)
- A supply of underwear for week
- Socks for week (one pair black for graduation)
- Handkerchiefs or tissues
- Jacket or sweater (in case of cool weather)
- Pair of Jeans
- Belt for jeans and military BDU/IDU cargo pants (pants to be provided)
- White t-shirts (3+) with no writing for PT (Physical Training)
- o Pajamas or sweatpants with shirt
- Sneakers for day to day wear and for PT
- Gym Shorts
- o Black dress pants or slacks for graduation
- Black shoes for graduation (no sneakers)

No laundry facility is available so a week's worth of clothing is required. We will supply you with a polo shirt for graduation, two uniform t-shirts with logo for daily wear, ball cap, water bottle, and plastic poncho which are yours to keep. A pair of military BDY/IDU cargo pants will be provided for day to day wear which must be turned in on the last day. Make sure you bring a belt for these pants. All other equipment will be provided. Bedding for the week will be furnished by the Vermont Police Academy.
